

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE
OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS OF 1950

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission of the City of Urbana, Illinois did on the 18th day of August, A. D. 1951 at the hour of 2 o'clock P.M., conduct a public hearing in the Council Room of the City Building in the City of Urbana, Illinois to consider recommending a proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance of Urbana, Illinois of 1950 eliminating or modifying the off-street parking area requirements applicable to churches; and

Whereas, said City Plan Commission at said hearing heard all persons desiring to be heard either for or against said amendment and found that the elimination or modification of the off-street parking requirements applicable to churches would not unreasonably impair the public health and safety of the people of Urbana, nor impair an adequate supply of light or air to adjacent property, nor unreasonably increase the congestion in public streets nor unreasonably increase the danger of fire; nor unreasonably danger nor impair established property values within the City of Urbana; and

Whereas, the City Plan Commission has recommended that this amendment to the Zoning Ordinance be adopted by the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That Section 6 of Article 11 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois of 1950 be and the same is hereby amended by requiring only the following off-street parking area to be supplied by churches which are hereafter erected within the City of Urbana:
