ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE OF THE
CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, FOR YEAR BEGINNING
MAY 1, 1951, AND ENDING APRIL 30, 1952

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, did on the 16th day of July, 1951; being within the first quarter of the fiscal year of said City which began on May 1st, 1951, and ends on April 30th, 1952, adopt the annual appropriation bill of said City for the fiscal year beginning May 1st, 1951, which said ordinance was approved by the Mayor who signed the same on July 16, 1951, and the same was duly published on July 19, 1951, as required by law.

NOW THEREFORE, for the purpose of supplying a revenue to meet said appropriation: -

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS: -

SECTION 1. That there is hereby levied and assessed upon all property subject to taxation within said City of Urbana, Illinois, as the same is assessed and equalized for state and county purposes for the current fiscal year, the sum of \$72,180.00, which sum is exclusive of any and all amounts hereinafter levied for the purposes authorized by acts which by their terms provide that taxes may be levied for such purpose, and when levied shall be in addition to taxes for general corporate purposes, and is hereby levied for the fiscal year beginning May 1st, 1951 and ending April 30th, 1952, and for the particular purposes as follows:

For purposes authorized by special acts and in addition to amount levied for general corporate purposes:

SECTION 2. There is hereby levied and assessed for the Firemen's Pension Fund, the sum of \$4,000.00; pursuant to an act of the General Assembly of the State, entitled "An Act to Provide For the Creation, Setting Apart, Maintenance and Administration of the Firemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund in Cities, Townships, Villages and Incorporated Towns Having a Population of not less than 100,000 Inhabitants." Approved and in force July 31, 1943. Said sum being in addition to the aggregate amount heretofore herein levied for general corporate purposes; Amount appropriated was \$4,000.00.

SECTION 3. There is hereby levied and assessed for the Police Pension Fund, the sum of \$3,000.00; pursuant to an act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois, entitled "An Act to Provide for the Setting Apart, Formation and Disbursement of a Police Pension Fund in Cities and Villages, etc.," approved June 14, 1909, as subsequently amended. Said sum hereby levied shall be in addition to the aggregate amount heretofore herein levied for general corporate purposes. Amount appropriated was \$3,000.00.

SECTION 4. There is hereby levied and assessed for a public comfort station in the City of Urbana, Illinois, the sum of \$8,000.00; pursuant to Section 56-1 to 5 inclusive, of Chapter 24, (Cities and Villages Act) of the Revised Statutes of the State of Illinois. Said sum shall be in addition to the aggregate amount herein levied for general corporate purposes, and shall be disbursed as follows:

There is hereby levied and assessed for the purpose of maintaining the Urbana Free Library and Reading Room, the sum of \$19,650.00; pursuant to an act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois, entitled "An Act to Authorize Cities and Villages, Incorporated Towns and Townships to Establish and Maintain Free Public Libraries and Reading Rooms," approved and in force March 7, 1872, as subsequently amended, and pursuant to the results of a special election wherein the voters of the City approved the increase of said tax rate from one and two-tenth mills to two mills. Said sum shall be in addition to the aggregate amount hereinbefore levied for general corporate purposes shall disbursed as follows:

There is hereby levied and assessed the sum of \$8,000.00 for the purpose of the Municipality's portion of contributions from January 1, 1951 to April 30, 1952 to the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund for the pensioning of municipal employees as provided in an act entitled "An Act to provide for the creation and operation of a retirement and benefit fund for the benefit of certain officers and employees, and their beneficiaries, of cities having a population of not more than two hundred thousand inhabitants, villages, incorporated towns, counties, having a population of not more than five hundred thousand inhabitants, and certain other governmental districts in the State, and to supersede certain other pension and benefit funds," pursuant to Paragraph 1198 of Chapter 24 of Illinois Revised Statutes of 1949, which said sum shall be in addition to the aggregate amount herein heretofore levied for general corporate purposes. The same amount was appropriated.

SECTION 13. There is hereby levied and assessed, the sum of \$4,500.00; for the exclusive purpose of lighting the streets of the City of Urbana, Illinois;

pursuant to Section 69-5 of Chapter 24 (Cities and Villages Act) of the Revised Statutes of the State of Illinois, and pursuant to the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the aldermen elected to the City Council of the City of Urbana. Said sum shall be in addition to the aggregate amount hereinbefore appropriated for general corporate purposes and shall be disbursed as follows:
