## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS: -

Section I. That beginning May 1, 1951, the monthly salaries of the following named officers and employees of the City of Urbana, Illinois, shall be as follows:

Section II. Beginning May 1, 1951, the annual salary of the
Corporation Counsel shall be 200.00
Section III. For each regular or special meeting of the City
Council attended by him, each alderman shall receive a compensation of 5.00
Section IV. All employees who shall have been employed continuously

for a minimum of one year upon the public streets or public sewers shall receive wages at the rate of \$255.00 per month. All other employees in the Street Department or working in the sewer or drainage Department, who shall be employed by the City for less than one year, and all helpers of the City Electrician or working in the electrical department shall receive \$1.25 per hour.

Section V. Each member of the Civil Service Commission shall receive \$10.00 per year full payment of his services on the said Commission.

Section VI. The Commissioner of Public Works shall furnish his own automobile or truck for his use in city business. The City shall furnish the gasoline and oil for said City use and shall also furnish public liability and property damage insurance for said automobile or truck to cover the performance of the duties of said officer of said City.

Section VII. In addition to the compensation hereinabove fixed, the Mayor, Corporation Counsel, the City Clerk shall receive such compensation for services to the Board of Local Improvements of the City of Urbana, Illinois as shall from time to time be determined by the Board of Local Improvements of said City, and nothing herein contained shall be construed as limiting the Board of Local Improvements in paying the said officers compensation for services rendered to said Board.

Section VIII. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
