AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING VEHICLES
CARRYING LOADS WITHIN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That An Ordinance Regulating Vehicles Carrying Loads Within the City of Urbana, Illinois, adopted by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois on the 16th day of April, A. D. 1951, and approved by the Mayor on the 17th day of April, A. D. 1951, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of said ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:


LICENSE REQUIRED. It shall be unlawful in the City of Urbana, Illinois to use or permit the use of any truck, wagon, cart, moving van, tractor, trailer or other vehicle registered from an address in the City of Urbana, Illinois, with either the Secretary of State or with the Department of Public Works and Buildings of the State of Illinois, for the carrying of loads for delivery to any place in said City unless a license for such vehicle is obtained as provided herein.

Section 2. Section 2 of said ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

EXCEPTIONS. This ordinance shall not apply to the following vehicles:

- (a) taxicabs,
- (b) omnibuses and school buses,
- (c) passenger vehicles unless they are used regularly for commercial deliveries in the City,
- (d) vehicles which have been licensed under any other ordinance of the City of Urbana and all non-commercial vehicles,
- (e) vehicles which are regularly engaged in interstate deliveries.
