

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING STORAGE
OF COMBUSTABLES IN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That An Ordinance Regulating Storage of Combustables in the City of Urbana, Illinois, which was adopted by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois on the 16th day of April, A. D. 1951 and which was approved by the Mayor on the 17th day of April, A. D. 1951, be and the same is hereby amended by substituting the following Section 2 in place of Section 2 of said ordinance:

Section 2. FEES FOR LICENSES: The fee to be paid to the City Clerk for an annual license to operate any such storing place, shall be as follows:

Gasoline and petroleum products bulk storage plants,.....	\$ 25.00
Gun powder and nitroglycerin bulk storage plants,.....	25.00
Turpentine, tar, pitch, resin, hemp and cotton, gun powder and nitroglycerin storage, including laundries, dry cleaning establishments and gasoline filling stations... ..	10.00

Section 4 of said ordinance is hereby amended by adding the following regulations to the regulations contained therein:

Every gasoline filling station, laundry, dry cleaning establishment and other premises where any combustables or explosive materials are stored (excluding storage for / heating on the premises) shall provide at least two (2) carbon dioxide or foam type hand fire extinguishers on the premises in an accessible location and in good operating condition. It shall be the duty of the person in control of the premises to keep said fire extinguishers in good operating condition at all times and the same shall be inspected at least once every six (6) months by the Fire Marshal of the City of Urbana or by one of the firemen of the Fire Department under the direction of the Fire Marshal.

Each bulk storage plant located within the City of Urbana, Illinois, shall provide at least five (5) three (3) gallon buckets filled with sand in accessible locations on the premises where such combustables are stored, for use in extinguishing or preventing the spreading of fire.
