

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING  
TRAILER, CABIN, TOURIST AND OTHER CAMPS

In Effect October 13, 1948

As Amended June 5, 1950

and as Amended April 16, 1951

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That an Ordinance Regulating Trailer Cabin, Tourist and Other Camps of the City of Urbana, Illinois, published by authority of the City Council on October 13, 1948, as amended on June 5, 1950 and as amended on April 16, 1951, be and the same is hereby amended as follows, to-wit:

The provisions of Section 3, Paragraph 4 of said ordinance are hereby amended to read as follows:


An annual permit to operate a camp will be issued only after application has been made by the owner, legal agent of the owner, or lessee of the location, which application will be on forms supplied by the City Clerk and after such applicant has filed a plat with the City Clerk setting forth the area and dimensions of the camp and showing thereon the dimensions of each trailer location. Both the application and the plat shall be approved in writing by the Health Officer before the permit is granted. After April 30, 1951, no permit shall be granted for the creation of a new trailer camp or for the location of any additional trailers or trailer spaces in any single family residence district, multiple residence district or in any area established as a fire zone in the City of Urbana. Permits will be granted for the operation of trailer camps which were in existence on April 1, 1951 in the single and 2 family residence districts of the City for the period from May 1, 1951 to June 30, 1951, providing the City Clerk is paid a fee of \$5 per trailer location for said two months period. After June 30, 1951, it shall be unlawful for any person to use for residential purposes, any trailer in a single or 2 family residence district of the City of Urbana, and it shall be likewise, unlawful for the owner of the premises to permit his property to be used as a location for trailers which are used for residential purposes.

Trailer spaces and trailer camps which have heretofore been established and permitted in the R-2 multiple family residence district of the City may be continued in such R-2 multiple family residence district until June 30, 1952 providing the annual permit fee of \$10 for each trailer location is paid to the

City Clerk of the City of Urbana for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 1951 and an additional fee of \$5 per trailer location is paid to the City for the period from May 1, 1952 to June 30, 1952, and providing that during the period from May 1, 1951 until June 30, 1952, no trailer space in such R-2 multiple family residence district shall be rented to any tenant who was not the tenant of such trailer space on May 1, 1951.

It shall be unlawful after June 30, 1952 for any person to use for residential purposes, any trailer in the R-2 multiple family residence district of the City of Urbana, and it shall further be unlawful for the owner or person in control of any real estate located in such R-2 multiple family residence district to permit any real estate located in such district to be used for a residential trailer location after June 30, 1952.
