AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY

WHEREAS, the adjoining property owners have, by proper petition, requested the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois to vacate the following described alley, to-wit:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Lot Five (5) of Thomas Lindsey's Addition to the City of Urbana, thence East Twelve feet (12'), thence South to the North line of Illinois Street, thence West a distance of Twelve feet (12'), thence North to the place of beginning, situated in the City of Urbana, County of Champaign and State of Illinois

which said alley is known as Thorne Alley and the portion of which is being vacated, lies between High Street on the North and Illinois Street on the South, said alley running North and South midway between South Broadway and South Walnut Streets in the City of Urbana; and

Whereas, it appears that there are no objectors to the closing of said alley, but that the owners of all of the properties which could possibly be served by said alley have joined in the petition for the vacation thereof; and

Whereas, it appears that said alley has no useful purpose, but that it would be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana that said alley be vacated.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, does hereby vacate and release to the owners of the abutting property, all right, title and interest of the City of Urbana to the alley described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Lot Five (5) of Thomas Lindsey's Addition to the City of Urbana, thence East Twelve feet (12'), thence South to the North line of Illinois Street, thence West a distance of Twelve feet (12'), thence North to the place of beginning, situated in the City of Urbana, County of Champaign and State of Illinois

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
