

**AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE
CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that a petition was filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois on the 7th day of July, A. D. 1952, requesting the annexation of the territory hereinafter described, which said petition was signed under oath by Herbert L. King, President of Champaign-Urbana Acre Assoc. Homestead Association, Urbana Project, Incorporated, the owner of all of said real estate in said territory in which there are no electors residing; and

Whereas, more than two-thirds of the aldermen are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois that said territory be annexed to, and made a part of the city limits of said city.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That the territory described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section Sixteen (16), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Nine (9) East of the Third Principal Meridian; running thence along section line, East Thirty feet (30'); thence North Three Hundred Sixty (360) feet for a true point of beginning; thence North parallel with the North and South quarter section line, One Thousand Three Hundred Three and Thirty-eight Hundredths feet (1,303.38') to the Southwest-erly right of way line of the Sidney Branch of the Wabash Railroad; thence along said Southwest-erly right of way line, South Forty-six degrees Forty-seven and one-half minutes East (S 46° 47½' E), One Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-four and Fifty-eight Hundredths (1,764.58) feet to the East line of said Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section Sixteen (16); thence South Zero degrees Nine and one-half minutes East (S 0° 9½' E), Four Hundred Sixty-nine and Ninety-five Hundredths feet (469.95') to said section line; thence North Eighty-nine degrees Twenty and one-half minutes West (N 89° 20½' W), Nine Hundred Twenty-eight and Six Tenths feet (928.6'); thence North Three Hundred Sixty feet (360'); thence North Eighty-nine degrees Twenty and one-half minutes West (N 89° 20½' W), Three Hundred Sixty feet (360') to the true point of beginning; Containing Twenty-eight and Fifty-seven Hundredths Acres (28.57 A); Otherwise described as:

The West Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section Sixteen (16) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Nine (9) East of the Third Principal Meridian, lying Southwest-erly from the Southwest-erly right of way line of the Sidney Branch of the Wabash Railroad and Easterly from the Easterly right of way line of State Aid Route No. 4 and excepting the highway and the South Three Hundred Sixty feet (360') of the West Three Hundred Ninety feet (390') of said West Half of the Southeast Quarter of said

Section Sixteen (16) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Nine (9) East of the Third Principal Meridian; Containing Twenty-eight and Fifty-seven Hundredths Acres (28.57 A); Also:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section Sixteen (16) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Nine (9) East of the Third Principal Meridian; and running thence North Eighty-nine degrees Eighteen minutes West ($N 89^{\circ} 18' W$), Thirty feet (30') for a true point of beginning; Continuing thence along the South line of said Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, North Eighty-nine degrees Eighteen minutes West ($N 89^{\circ} 18' W$), One Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-two and Thirty-eight Hundredths feet (1,292.38') to the West line of said Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter; thence along said West line, North Nine Hundred Seventy-seven and Forty-nine Hundredths feet (977.49') to the Southwest corner of Lot Fifty-eight (58) of Martha C. Hubbard's Second Addition to Urbana, Illinois; thence along South line of said Lot Fifty-eight (58), South Eighty-nine degrees Eighteen minutes East ($S 89^{\circ} 18' E$), Five Hundred Seventy-seven and Fifty-one Hundredths feet (577.51') to the Southwesterly right of way line of State Aid Route No. 4; thence along said right of way line, South Forty-six degrees Thirty-nine minutes East ($S 46^{\circ} 39' E$), Eight Hundred Twenty-eight and Ninety-nine Hundredths (828.99) feet; thence continuing along said Southwesterly and Westerly highway right of way line along a circular curve to the right with a radius of Three Hundred Fifty-seven and Fifteen Hundredths feet (357.15'), a distance of Two Hundred Ninety and Seventy-nine Hundredths feet (290.79') and South One Hundred Fifty-seven and Eighty-one Hundredths feet (157.81') to the true point of beginning; Containing Twenty-three and Four Hundred Sixty-three Thousandths Acre (23.463 A); Otherwise described as:

The Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section Sixteen (16) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Nine (9) East of the Third Principal Meridian, lying South of Lot Fifty-eight (58) of Martha C. Hubbard's Second Addition to Urbana, Illinois, and lying Southwesterly and Westerly from the Southwesterly and Westerly right of way line of State Aid Route No. 4; Containing Twenty-three and Four Hundred Sixty-three Thousandths Acres (23.463 A); Also that portion of State Aid Route NO. 4 which lies between the two above described tracts of real estate All situated in the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, the Northwest Quarter and Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter all in Section Sixteen (16) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Nine (9) East of the Third Principal Meridian, in the County of Champaign and State of Illinois.

be, and the same is hereby annexed to, and shall hereafter be a part of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the corporate limits of said city be, and the same shall be changed so as to include said territory within the corporate limits of said city.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, shall record with the Recorder of Deeds of the County of Champaign, Illinois, a copy of this ordinance, together with an accurate map of the annexed territory.
