

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING  
TRAILER, CABIN, TOURIST AND OTHER CAMPS  
In Effect October 13, 1948  
As Amended June 5, 1950  
As Amended April 16, 1951  
And As Amended May 7, 1951

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS: -

That

SECTION 1. That Section 5 of An Ordinance Regulating Trailer, Cabin, Tourist and Other Camps of the City of Urbana, Illinois, adopted October 4, 1948, is hereby amended by adding the following Item XIII to said Section of said Ordinance:

ITEM XIII: FIRE LANE. It shall be the duty of the owner, operator or person in control of any and all trailer, cabin and tourist camps and courts within the City of Urbana, Illinois, to provide an all weather surfaced street or lane of at least fourteen feet (14') in width into each portion of said camp in which trailers are located and each trailer location shall have frontage on said street or lane. Said owner, operator or person in control of any such camp shall at all times, keep said street or lane free of parked automobiles and all other obstructions to permit the fire fighting equipment of the City of Urbana to have access to each and every trailer or cabin in such park or camp. The provisions of this Item, however, shall not apply to trailer camps in which there are less than four (4) trailers, or trailer spaces, located, or provided in said camp.

SECTION 2. It shall henceforth be unlawful for any trailer to be used for residential purposes in the City of Urbana, Illinois, unless said trailer is provided with an escape door at the rear of said trailer or is provided with an escape hatch at the opposite end of said trailer from the door thereto. The owner of any trailer not provided with a rear door or escape hatch as required herein, shall provide such rear door or escape hatch within ten (10) days after being ordered so to do by the Health Inspector or any Police Officer or Fire Inspector of the City of Urbana, and in event of the failure of the owner to make such provisions within such time, said owner shall be guilty of a violation of this ordinance.
