

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE
OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS OF 1950 BY RECLASSIFYING
AS R-2 MULTIPLE FAMILY RESIDENCE AREA, LOT SIX (6) OF
BLOCK TEN (10) OF SEMINARY ADDITION TO URBANA

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission of the City of Urbana, Illinois did, on the 2nd day of January, A. D. 1953, at the hour of 4:00 o'clock P.M., conduct a public hearing in the Council Room of the City Building in Urbana, Illinois, to consider among other things, an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance of 1950 providing for the reclassification of Lot Six (6) of Block Ten (10) of Seminary Addition to the City of Urbana as R-2 Multiple Residence Area, and

Whereas, notice of such public hearing was duly published in the Champaign-Urbana Courier more than fifteen days preceding the date of such hearing, whereby public notice was given of the particular location for which the amendment was to be considered, as well as a brief statement describing the proposed amendment, and

Whereas, the City Plan Commission of the City of Urbana has, after hearing all persons who desired to be heard either for or against such amendment, recommended to the City Council of the City of Urbana that said amendment be adopted by the City Council, and

Whereas, it appears to the City Council that said amendment to the Zoning Ordinance is reasonable and necessary to prevent an unnecessary hardship in this particular case, and that the reclassification of such property will not impair an adequate supply of light and air to adjacent property, increase the congestion in public streets, increase the danger of fire or endanger the public safety, nor unreasonably diminish nor impair established property values within the surrounding area.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That the following described real estate, to-wit:

Lot Six (6) of Block Ten (10) of Seminary
Addition to the City of Urbana, situated in
the County of Champaign and State of Illinois

is hereby classified as R-2 Multiple Residence Area under the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana of 1950.
