

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE
 REGULATING THE PARKING AND OPERATION OF VEHICLES
 AND THE USE OF THE STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,
 APPROVED OCTOBER 21, 1924

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS; -

That Section 9 of An Ordinance Regulating the Parking and Operation of Vehicles and the Use of the Streets Within the City of Urbana, Illinois, adopted October 20, 1924 and approved October 21, 1924, is hereby amended by substituting the following Section 9 in place of the Section 9 set forth in said ordinance:


SECTION 9. MARKED SPACES: When parking spaces are marked off on the pavement, vehicles shall be parked within such spaces, and where the curbing on a street has been or is painted with yellow paint under the direction of the City Council, then no vehicle shall be parked in said street adjacent to such yellow painted curbing.
