

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING
THE PARKING AND OPERATION OF VEHICLES, AND THE USE OF THE
STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, adopted on October 20, 1924, An Ordinance Regulating the Parking and Operation of Vehicles, and the Use of the Streets Within the City of Urbana, Illinois, which said ordinance was approved on October 21, 1924, and

Whereas, it appears that it would be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, to require all through trucks to follow the State Routes through said City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That An Ordinance Regulating the Parking and Operation of Vehicles, and the Use of the Streets Within the City of Urbana, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the following sections thereto:

SECTION 11.1. It shall be unlawful for the driver or operator of any truck being driven from a point of origin outside of the City of Urbana to a point of destination outside of the City of Urbana, to drive or cause said truck to be driven on any streets or alleys within the City of Urbana, Illinois, except those streets which have been designated as State Highways or upon such streets which have been marked with appropriate signs indicating that they are through truck routes. The City Council of the City of Urbana, shall, from time to time, cause appropriate signs to be erected on streets designated by such Council as through truck routes. This section shall not be construed to prohibit the drivers of trucks from using those streets of the City necessary to reach a load consigned from this City or to deliver a load consigned to an address in this City.
