AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CARNIVALS AND OTHER TYPES OF AMUSEMENTS WITHIN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to present, conduct, display or cause to be presented, conducted or displayed, any circuses, carnivals, menageries, caravans, side shows, exhibitions of freaks of nature or monsters within the corporate limits of the City of Urbana, Illinois.

SECTION 2. PENALTY: Any person, firm or corporation willfully violating the provisions of this ordinance, shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense and each day on which a violation of this ordinance occurs or continues shall be considered a separate offense.
