

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE NECESSITY FOR
IMPROVEMENT OF REAL ESTATE OF THE COUNTY OF CHAMPAIGN

WHEREAS, the Board of Local Improvements of the City of Urbana, Illinois has adopted a resolution for the Main Street, Bennett Avenue, Elm Street, Raising and Resurfacing Improvement No. 245-67CS, in the City of Urbana, Illinois, and

Whereas, a part of the proposed project consists of the construction of a Portland Cement Concrete sidewalk and street lights on the West side of Bennett Avenue from Main Street to Elm Street and further consists of the construction of street lights on the North side of Elm Street from Broadway to Bennett Avenue all on land now owned by the County of Champaign, and

Whereas, Paragraph 157 of Chapter 30 of Illinois Revised Statutes of 1953 provides that a municipality owning land may transfer such land to another municipality if the territory of the first municipality is partially within the second municipality, providing the transferee municipality shall by ordinance declare that it is necessary or convenient for it to use or occupy or improve any real estate held by the transferor municipality in the making of any public improvement or for any public purpose;

BE IT, THEREFORE, ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That in connection with the local improvement designated as Main Street, Bennett Avenue, Elm Street, Raising and Resurfacing Improvement No. 245-67CS, it is necessary or convenient for the City of Urbana to improve the following described real estate, to-wit:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of Bennett Avenue and Main Street in the City of Urbana, Illinois, thence West along the South line of Main Street Eight feet (8'), thence South on a line parallel with, and Eight feet (8') West of the West line of Bennett Avenue to a point Eight feet (8') North of the North line of Elm Street, thence West along a line parallel to and Eight feet (8') North of the North line of Elm Street to the East line of Broadway, thence South Eight feet (8') to the North line of Elm Street, thence East along the North line of Elm Street to the West line of Bennett Avenue, thence North along the West line of Bennett Avenue to the point of beginning, all situated in the County of Champaign and State of Illinois.


SECTION 2. The real estate above described consists of an Eight foot (8') strip of land off of the East side and an Eight foot (8') strip of land off of the South side of the tract of real estate now occupied and used by the County of Champaign for a Court House and Jail site in the City of Urbana, Illinois, and on which land the plans for the aforesaid local improvement call for the construction of new and modern street lights by the City of Urbana, and the construction of a sidewalk along the West side of Bennett Avenue.
