

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE MAIN STREET, BENNETT AVENUE, ELM STREET, RAISING AND RESURFACING IMPROVEMENT NO. 245-67CS, IN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Board of Local Improvements of the City of Urbana, Illinois has recommended in writing to the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, the construction of the local improvement to be known as Main Street, Bennett Avenue, Elm Street, Raising and Resurfacing Improvement No. 245-67CS, in the City of Urbana, Illinois, and has presented to the City Council, this ordinance providing for the construction of said improvement, together with the estimate of cost of said improvement over the signature of the President of the Board of Local Improvements of said City, itemized to the satisfaction of said Board and approved thereby; and

Whereas, the improvement hereinafter described is a necessary local improvement which will benefit the property to be assessed in the vicinity of said improvement and will further benefit the public in the entire City of Urbana, and will not require that private property be taken or damaged in the construction thereof;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That Main Street, Bennett Avenue and Elm Street in the City of Urbana, Illinois, be improved by the raising and resurfacing of the pavement on Main Street from Cedar Street to Bennett Avenue with Bituminous Concrete; the widening of the pavement on Main Street from Bennett Avenue to Vine Street to a width of Sixty-two feet (62') back to back of curb, and the resurfacing of same with Bituminous Concrete; the resurfacing of the pavement on Bennett Avenue from Elm Street to Main Street with Bituminous Concrete; the resurfacing of the pavement on Elm Street from Broadway Avenue to Bennett Avenue with Bituminous Concrete; the widening and resurfacing of the pavement on Elm Street from Bennett Avenue to Vine Street to a width of Forty feet (40') back to back of curb; the construction of Portland Cement Concrete sidewalks Ten feet (10') in width on both sides of Main Street from Bennett Avenue to Vine Street; the construction of a

Portland Cement Concrete sidewalk Six feet (6') in width along the West side of Bennett Avenue from Main Street to Elm Street; the construction of a new Ornamental Lighting System on Elm Street from Broadway Avenue to Vine Street and on Main Street from Bennett Avenue to Vine Street and on Bennett Avenue from Elm Street to Main Street; and including also, the reconstruction of the present Ornamental Lighting System in the Business District; and including the necessary drainage structures and incidental construction work, all in the City of Urbana, Illinois.

SECTION 2. That the profile of the grade for said improvement is hereby established as the grade for the finished surface of said pavement along the center line thereof on said street where the same is to be paved, and the center line of said pavement, at all points along said street, shall have the respective elevations above or below datum plane as shown on said profile hereto attached; the top of curb along all points on said street where the same is to be curbed shall be four inches above the grade to be established as the grade for said street when completed; such elevation having reference to the bench mark or datum plane established and fixed by an ordinance adopted by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, on the 7th day of August, 1905, and amended by an ordinance adopted on the 16th day of February, 1948; the elevation of said datum plane or bench mark as used in said profile being designated at 727.80, all figures above or below said elevation shall be designated in feet and all points along said proposed improvement shall have the elevation above or below said datum plane as indicated in feet above or below said 727.80.

SECTION 3. That the location and construction of said improvement shall in all respects conform to the detailed plans, maps, plats, profiles, estimate and specifications hereto attached, and that all materials and appliances used in the construction of said improvement shall be in the size, shape, style, dimensions, proportions and quality provided in the attached drawings, specifications and estimate, and the said improvement shall be installed at the places and at the elevations as provided in said drawings and specifications.

SECTION 4. The attached plans, plats, profiles, maps, specifications and estimate providing for the manner of construction of said improvement are expressly made a part of this ordinance by reference as fully and completely as if the same had been incorporated herein in full, and shall in all respects govern and control the construction and location of said improvement and the materials entering into the same, and in the interpretation of said plans, plats, profiles and specifications, the decisions of the Board of Local Improvements with reference thereto shall be final and binding.

SECTION 5. The construction of said improvement, including all work and materials therefor, as provided in this ordinance, is hereby declared to be a necessary local improvement, and shall be constructed at the place hereinbefore mentioned, and the cost thereof shall be paid by a special assessment on all the property specially benefited by the construction of said improvement to the extent of the special benefits thereon and by a general tax on all the property in the City of Urbana, Illinois, for the public benefits, to the extent of the public benefits thereon.

SECTION 6. There being no public engineer provided for the City of Urbana, Illinois, and the City Council having on the 2nd day of June, 1941, by resolution designated Jamison Vawter, a member of said City Council, as a member of the Board of Local Improvements, the Council finds that said board of Local Improvements is legally constituted as provided by Statute, and that the estimate of the cost of said improvement over the signature of the President of said Board of Local Improvements, submitted with the recommendations of said Board of Local Improvements and approved by the same, is hereby adopted and approved by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and the copy thereof hereto attached, being the estimate of cost as adopted at the public hearing on said improvement, is hereby made a part of this ordinance by reference as aforesaid.

SECTION 7. That the sum of \$9,363.00, being the amount included in the estimate of said President of the Board of Local Improvements hereto attached as the cost of engineering, supervision and inspection as estimated,

and the sum of \$6,735.00 as shown in said estimate as the estimate of the cost of making, levying and collecting the assessments herein, including court costs, shall be applied and set forth in said estimate of cost, as provided by an act entitled, "An Act Concerning Local Improvements" as amended.

SECTION 8. That the aggregate amount herein ordered to be assessed against the property and also the assessment against each lot, block, tract and parcel of land therein assessed, shall be divided into ten installments in the manner provided by the Statute in such cases made and provided, and each of said installments shall bear interest at the rate of five per cent per annum according to law.

SECTION 9. That for the purpose of anticipating the collection of the aforesaid second and succeeding installments, provided for in this ordinance, the City of Urbana, Illinois, shall issue bonds payable out of said installments, bearing interest at the rate of five per centum per annum, payable annually, and signed by the Mayor and City Clerk, under the corporate seal of said City; said bonds to be issued in the sum of One Hundred Dollars each, or some multiple thereof, and shall be issued in accordance with and shall in all respects conform to the provisions of said Local Improvement Act.

SECTION 10. The Corporation Counsel of the City of Urbana, Illinois, is hereby directed to file a petition in the name of the City of Urbana, Illinois, in the County Court of Champaign County, Illinois, praying that steps be taken to levy a special assessment for said improvement in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance and the laws of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 11. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

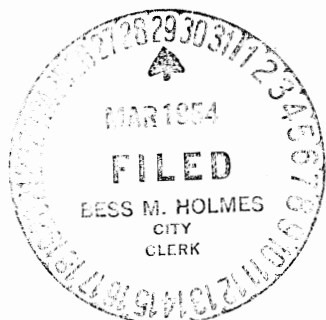

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE MAIN STREET, BENNETT AVENUE,
ELM STREET, RAISING AND RESURFACING IMPROVEMENT NO. 245-67CS,
IN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Local Improvements of the City of Urbana, Illinois has recommended in writing to the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, the construction of the local improvement to be known as Main Street, Bennett Avenue, Elm Street, Raising and Resurfacing Improvement No. 245-67CS, in the City of Urbana, Illinois, and has presented to the City Council, this ordinance providing for the construction of said improvement, together with the estimate of cost of said improvement over the signature of the President of the Board of Local Improvements of said City, itemized to the satisfaction of said Board and approved thereby; and

Whereas, the improvement hereinafter described is a necessary local improvement which will benefit the property to be assessed in the vicinity of said improvement and will further benefit the public in the entire City of Urbana, and will not require that private property be taken or damaged in the construction thereof;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That Main Street, Bennett Avenue and Elm Street in the City of Urbana, Illinois, be improved by the raising and resurfacing of the pavement on Main Street from Cedar Street to Bennett Avenue with Bituminous Concrete; the widening of the pavement on Main Street from Bennett Avenue to Vine Street to a width of Sixty-two feet (62') back to back of curb, and the resurfacing of same with Bituminous Concrete; the resurfacing of the pavement on Bennett Avenue from Elm Street to Main Street with Bituminous Concrete; the resurfacing of the pavement on Elm Street from Broadway Avenue to Bennett Avenue with Bituminous Concrete; the widening and resurfacing of the pavement on Elm Street from Bennett Avenue to Vine Street to a width of Forty feet (40') back to back of curb; the construction of Portland Cement Concrete sidewalks Ten feet (10') in width on both sides of Main Street from Bennett Avenue to Vine Street; the construction of a

Portland Cement Concrete sidewalk Six feet (6') in width along the West side of Bennett Avenue from Main Street to Elm Street; the construction of a new Ornamental Lighting System on Elm Street from Broadway Avenue to Vine Street and on Main Street from Bennett Avenue to Vine Street and on Bennett Avenue from Elm Street to Main Street; and including also, the reconstruction of the present Ornamental Lighting System in the Business District; and including the necessary drainage structures and incidental construction work, all in the City of Urbana, Illinois.

SECTION 2. That the profile of the grade for said improvement is hereby established as the grade for the finished surface of said pavement along the center line thereof on said street where the same is to be paved, and the center line of said pavement, at all points along said street, shall have the respective elevations above or below datum plane as shown on said profile hereto attached; the top of curb along all points on said street where the same is to be curbed shall be four inches above the grade to be established as the grade for said street when completed; such elevation having reference to the bench mark or datum plane established and fixed by an ordinance adopted by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, on the 7th day of August, 1905, and amended by an ordinance adopted on the 16th day of February, 1948; the elevation of said datum plane or bench mark as used in said profile being designated at 727.80, all figures above or below said elevation shall be designated in feet and all points along said proposed improvement shall have the elevation above or below said datum plane as indicated in feet above or below said 727.80.

SECTION 11. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

FINAL RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS
CONCERNING MAIN STREET, BENNETT AVENUE, ELM STREET, RAISING
AND RESURFACING IMPROVEMENT NO. 245-67CS

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of February, A. D. 1954 the Board of Local Improvements of the City of Urbana, Illinois, sent by mail, a notice directed to the persons who paid the general taxes for the last preceding year on each lot, block, tract or parcel of land fronting on the proposed improvement of Main Street from Cedar Street to Vine Street, on Bennett Avenue from Main Street to Elm Street and on Elm Street from Broadway Avenue to Vine Street, notifying said persons that the Board of Local Improvements had fixed the 3rd day of March, A. D. 1954 at the hour of 11:00 o'clock A.M. in the Council Chamber of the City Building in Urbana, Illinois, as the time and place for a public hearing on said proposed improvement; and

Whereas, the said Board of Local Improvements on the date, hour and place aforesaid, met for said public hearing and after hearing the representations of those persons at said public hearing on the subject of the necessity of the nature and the cost as estimated, and the extent of said public improvement and after all persons who desired to be heard, either for or against said public improvement, and said hearing having been continued to the 10th day of March, A. D. 1954 at 11:00 o'clock A.M. at the said place mentioned above, whereupon said Board heard other persons who desired to be heard in connection with the nature and extent and cost of said improvement and said meeting having been adjourned to 2:00 o'clock P.M. on March 10, 1954, at which time the said Board of Local Improvements determined that said improvement would be desirable in accordance with the estimate of cost as hereinafter set forth, the same being identical with the original estimate of cost contained in the original resolution of the Board of Local Improvements adopted on February 17, 1954, said Board did then and there on the 10th day of March, A. D. 1954, adopt the following resolution, to-wit:

PETITION FOR LEVY OF SPECIAL ASSESSMENT

TO THE HONORABLE EUGENE P. LIERMAN, JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Your petitioner, the City of Urbana, Illinois respectfully represents that it is a municipal corporation, organized and acting as such under and by virtue of an act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois, entitled "An Act Providing for the Incorporation of Cities and Villages," in force July 1, 1872.

Your petition further shows that on the 5th day of April, A. D. 1954 the City Council of said City adopted an ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance Providing for the Main Street, Bennett Avenue, Elm Street, Raising and Resurfacing Improvement No. 245-67CS," in the City of Urbana, Illinois, which ordinance was approved by the Mayor of said City on the 5th day of April, A. D. 1954.

Your petitioner attaches hereto and files with this petition, a copy of said ordinance certified by the Clerk of said City under the seal of said City; also a copy of the Recommendations of the Board of Local Improvements of said City for the passage of said ordinance by the City Council of said City; also a copy of the estimate of cost of said improvement over the signature of the President of the Board of Local Improvements of said City, together with a copy of the final resolution adopted by said Board at the public hearing on said proposed improvement, which said estimate of cost was approved by the said City Council, the Legislative Body of said City of Urbana, Illinois, which recommendation and estimate of cost is certified by the Clerk of said City under the corporate seal of said City, all of which

your petitioner files with this petition, together with a copy of the plans, profiles, plats and specifications for the construction of said improvement, all of which your petitioner files with this petition and makes a part thereof by reference.

Your petitioner prays that steps be taken to levy a special assessment for said improvement in accordance with the provisions of said ordinance and an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois, entitled "An Act Concerning Local Improvements," approved June 14, 1897 as amended.
