

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE CODE OF THE  
CITY OF URBANA OF 1954

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Article 1 of Chapter 14 is hereby amended as follows:


Section 14.2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 14.2. DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE. The keeper of every tenement house, lodging house, restaurant, boarding house, hotel, bakery, private residence or other place with a kitchen having refuse of an organic character commonly known as garbage, shall provide for the disposal of such garbage by a duly licensed sanitary hauler who shall be required to remove it at least once per week; such material shall be deposited in receptacles which are flytight and made of galvanized iron or other impervious material, and which shall have a solid bottom, a tight-fitting lid and which shall be of not more than thirty (30) gallons in capacity. All garbage must be deposited in said cans to facilitate the burying of said garbage at the Dumping Grounds by use of the land fill method of garbage disposal. No brush, tree trunks or twigs or limbs shall be mixed with the garbage to be buried, but such material shall be hauled separately to the Dumping Grounds where same may be burned under the direction of the Custodian of the Dumping Grounds at times and at locations which he may designate. No accumulated garbage within the City of Urbana shall be burned, nor shall it be allowed to become offensive to sight or smell, or dangerous to the health of occupants in the neighborhood, but shall be removed often enough to meet the requirements of the Health Authority for the promotion of healthful conditions in the City. The City Council may, from time to time, adopt rules concerning the operation of the Dumping Grounds and any violation of any rule so adopted shall be considered a violation of this Ordinance and shall subject the violator to the general penalty provided herein.

Section 14.5. USE OF CITY DUMP, is amended to read as follows:

Section 14.5. USE OF CITY DUMP. No person shall use the City Dump unless such person is a licensed sanitary hauler or has received a special permit from the City Clerk, the fee, if any for which shall be established by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, on the load basis. The City Clerk upon issuing a permit for said dumping shall provide the permittee with a proper written permit, which shall be presented to the Custodian of the Dump Ground. Upon this permit the Custodian shall indicate that a load was delivered and shall return the permit to the City Clerk who shall make proper accounting thereof. No sales of gravel at the Dumping Grounds other than those by the Custodian shall be made without written authorization of the Mayor and a record of such sale shall be kept by the City Clerk. Sales of gravel made by the Custodian shall be recorded on duplicate receipt forms, the original of which shall be delivered to the purchaser at the time of payment for such gravel and the duplicate of which shall be filed with the City Clerk. All sales of gravel shall be paid for by the purchaser at the time of delivery at the pit, by check made payable to the City of Urbana to be paid to the Custodian at the time of loading. The Custodian shall deliver said checks to the City Clerk once each week and the City Clerk shall deposit said funds in the Garbage Disposal Funds of said City. At the first meeting of each month, the City Clerk shall report to the City Council the amount of gravel sold at the Dumping Grounds and the amount of money received from such sales.
