AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that a petition was filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois on the 20th day of December, A. D. 1954, requesting the annexation of the territory hereinafter described, which said petition was signed under oath by David F. Hubbard, and Howard O. Watson, the owners of all of said real estate in said territory in which there are no electors residing; and

WHEREAS, more than two-thirds of the aldermen are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois that said territory be annexed to, and made a part of the city limits of said City.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That the territory described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 20. Township 19 North. Range 9 East of the 3rd Principal Meridian, thence South 0° 29* East 443.0 feet, thence South 89° 38* West 185 feet, thence South 0° 29* East 35 feet, thence South 89° 38* West 185 feet, thence South 89° 38* West 380.48 feet, thence North 0° 38* West 478 feet to the center line of Colorado Avenue, thence North 89° 38* East 566.70 feet to the place of beginning, situated in Champaign County, Illinois,

be, and the same is hereby annexed to, and shall hereafter be a part of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the corporate limits of said City be, and the same shall be changed so as to include said territory within the corporate limits of said City.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, shall record with the Recorder of Deeds of the County of Champaign, Illinois, a copy of this ordinance, together with an accurate map of the annexed territory.
