AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING
THE SALE AT RETAIL OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS WITH-
IN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That Section 4 of An Ordinance Regulating the
Sale at Retail of Alcoholic Liquors Within the City of Urbana,
Illinois, is hereby amended by substituting the following
Section 4 in lieu of the Section 4 therein:

SECTION 4. (Classification-fees) Such licenses shall be
and are hereby divided into four classes, to-wit:

(a) Class A licenses (to be known as regular retailer's
license) which shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic
liquors in package form or by the drink for consumption on or
off the premises where sold. The annual license fee for which
shall be (except hotels) \$1,000.00. Hotels \$1,400.00.


(b) Class B licenses (to be known as the beer license) which
shall authorize the retail sale of beer only to be consumed on
or off the premises where sold. The annual license fee for which
shall be \$250.00 in the unrestricted area defined in Section 11
hereof, and \$400.00 in the restricted area defined in Section 11
hereof.

(c) Class C licenses (to be known as package store licenses)
which shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquors in
original packages not to be consumed on the premises. The annual
license fee for which shall be \$1,250.00.

(d) Class D licenses which shall authorize the retail sale
of alcoholic liquors by clubs and to members only to be consumed
in the club rooms only. The annual license fee shall be \$1,000.00.

(d-1) Class D-1 licenses which shall authorize the retail sale
of beer only, within the Liquor Zone of the City by clubs to members
only, to be consumed in the club rooms only, the annual license
fee for which shall be \$250.00.
