AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A REVISION AND CODIFICATION
OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF URBANA, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS,
PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCES NOT INCLUDED THEREIN WITH CERTAIN
EXCEPTIONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES HEREINAFTER SET OUT

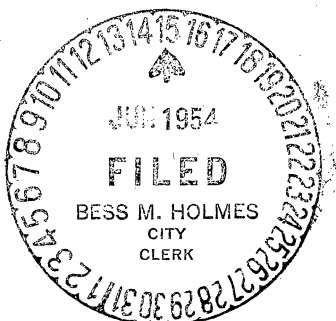
WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, has caused its ordinances of a general and permanent nature to be compiled and revised, and the same embodied in a compilation and revision thereof, known as "The Code of the City of Urbana, Illinois, 1954".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That the ordinances of the City of Urbana, Illinois, of a general and permanent nature as revised and codified in the following chapters, namely, Chapters 1 to 33, both inclusive, are hereby ordained as general ordinances of the City of Urbana, Illinois, as authorized by the Revised Cities and Villages Act, Chapter 24, paragraph 10--2, and are adopted as, and shall constitute "The Code of the City of Urbana, Illinois, 1954".

SECTION 2. That the provisions of such Code shall be in force on and after September 1, 1954, and all ordinances of a general and permanent nature in force on May 24, 1954, and not contained in such Code are hereby repealed from and after the 1st day of September, 1954, except as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 3. That the repeal provided for in the preceding section of this ordinance shall not affect any offense or act committed or done or any penalty or forfeiture incurred or any contract or right established or accruing before the 1st day of September, 1954; nor shall such repeal affect any ordinance or resolution promising or guaranteeing the payment of money for the City or authorizing the issue of any bonds of the City or any evidence of the City's indebtedness, or any contract or obligation assumed by the City; nor shall such repeal affect the administrative ordinances or resolutions of the Council not in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of such Code;




nor shall it repeal or affect any ordinances or resolutions of said City concerning or providing for franchises of persons or corporations; nor An Ordinance Creating and Establishing a Bench Mark or Datum Plane, adopted by the City Council on August 7, 1905, as amended on February 16, 1948; nor any ordinances providing for bond issues, either of a general or local improvement nature; nor any ordinances providing for annual salaries of city officers and employees, annual appropriations, and annual or special tax levies; nor any ordinances affecting annexations, elections, creation of wards or changes in boundaries thereof; nor local improvement ordinances, nor any of the ordinances of this City regulating the sale at retail of alcoholic liquors; nor any ordinances providing for civilian defense; nor Ordinances Regulating Trailer Coach Parks, Tourist and Other Camps With the City; nor the Zoning Ordinance of 1950 and amendments thereto; nor An Ordinance Creating the Office of Electrical Inspector and Providing for the Inspection of and Regulation of Electrical Installations in the City, and amendments thereto; nor any ordinances concerning the installation of plumbing fixtures and establishing standards for such installations within the City; nor shall it affect any prosecution, suit or proceeding pending or any judgment rendered on or prior to the 1st day of September, 1954; nor shall it affect any ordinance passed after May 24, 1954.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall go into effect not less than ten days after publication of such Code as authorized by the Revised Cities and Villages Act, Chapter 24, paragraph 10-3.
