AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING CONNECTIONS TO SEWERS UNDER  
THE CONTROL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, there is in existence within the City of Urbana, Illinois, certain systems of storm drainage sewers and sanitary sewers, some of which extend beyond the corporate limits of said City, and

WHEREAS, in the development and growth of the City it is sometimes desirable for connections to be made to said sewers by persons who have never contributed to the cost of installation thereof, and on other occasions it is desirable for subdividers to extend sewers both within and beyond the corporate limits of said City and to pay the cost of such extension without any immediate financial assistance from land owners who might be benefited at some future time as a result of such sewer extensions:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS: - That

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation or municipality to extend, connect to, or cause to be made, an extension or connection to any storm drain or sanitary sewer which is in whole or in part maintained, controlled or owned by the City of Urbana, Illinois, without first having obtained permission for such connection or extension from the Commissioner of Public Works of the City of Urbana, Illinois.

SECTION 2. The Commissioner of Public Works of the City of Urbana shall not grant permission for the extension of any storm drain or sanitary sewer beyond the corporate limits of said City without first having submitted the question of such extension to the Street, Alley and Sewer Committee of the City Council, which Committee shall investigate the area to be served by said sewer extension and shall determine the fee for such connection or extension.

SECTION 3. Whenever a municipality, person, firm or corporation desires to extend an existing sewer or drain which is controlled by the City, and has not contributed his or its fair proportionate share of the cost of the

existing sewer or drain, then the person, firm, corporation or municipality extending such sewer or drain shall be required to reimburse each person, firm, corporation or municipality who paid or contributed to the cost of the existing sewer or drain and such reimbursement must be made or agreed upon prior to the permit for the extension of the sewer being granted by the City. The reimbursement shall be calculated upon a pro-rata basis.


SECTION 4. Any person, firm, corporation or municipalities violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$5.00 and not more than \$200.00 and each day a violation continues shall be deemed a separate offence.
