AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION
OF CERTAIN SIDEWALKS WITHIN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, did on the 30th day of April, A. D. 1955, adopt an ordinance requiring the construction of a concrete sidewalk on both sides of Anderson Street from the South curb line of Washington Street to the North curb line of Florida Avenue, and

WHEREAS, a majority of the aldermen of said City desire to amend said ordinance to permit the construction of a Four foot (4') sidewalk instead of the Five foot (5') sidewalk required in the Code of the City of Urbana of 1954,


THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That Section 1 of "An Ordinance for the Construction of Certain Sidewalks Within the City of Urbana, Illinois," adopted on April 30, 1955, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. That concrete sidewalks Four feet (4') in width shall be constructed in the City of Urbana, Illinois at the following locations, to-wit:

Upon both sides of Anderson Street from the South curb line of Washington Street to the North curb line of Florida Avenue, and also the necessary sidewalk stubs to curb lines on Anderson Street, excepting, however, that no new sidewalk shall be constructed on the portions of said street where a sidewalk has previously been constructed of Four feet (4') in width, in accordance with the specifications set forth in Sections 30.27 to 30.46 of the Code of the City of Urbana, Illinois of 1954."

Adopted by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, this 16th day of May, A. D. 1955.
