

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 20.96 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS OF 1954

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That Section 20.96 of the Code of the City of Urbana, Illinois of 1954 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 20.96. Horns and other warning devices.

A person driving an automobile within the limits of the city, shall have same properly equipped with a horn or other device for signaling by sound to give warning of its approach. No horn, ~~or~~ or other signaling device shall be used, except as necessary to give warning. Siren signaling devices shall not be used on any vehicle except authorized emergency vehicles.
