AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CONDEMNATION OF CERTAIN REAL ESTATE

WHEREAS, it is provided in the Local Improvement Act of the State of Illinois that private property may be taken or damaged for public purposes upon condemnation of such property by ordinance of the City Council of the City, wherein said property is located, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that the hereinafter described real estate be condemned in connection with the construction of the local improvement concerning the Southeast Storm Relief Project No. 257-80CS, in the City of Urbana, Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS: That -

SECTION 1. In connection with the construction of the local improvement designated as the Southeast Storm Relief Project No. 257-80CS, in the City of Urbana, Illinois, it will be necessary to deposit earth fill upon the following described real estate, to-wit:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Lot 1 of W. B. and Pearl Webber's Anderson Street Addition, thence West to a point 183 feet East of the center line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 17, Township 19, North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, thence South 325.45 feet, thence East to the Southeast corner of Lot 4 of said W. B. and Pearl Webber's Anderson Street Addition, thence North 325.45 feet to the place of beginning, all situated in the Southeast Quarter of Section 17, Township 19, North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian in Champaign County, Illinois,

and, therefore, said real estate is condemned for that purpose.


SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval as required by law.
