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AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CONDEMNATION OF CERTAIN REAL ESTATE

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WHEREAS, it is provided in the Local Improvement Act of the State of Illinois that private property may be taken or damaged for public purposes upon condemnation of such property by ordinance of the City Council of the City wherein said property is located, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that the hereinafter described real estate be condemned in connection with the construction of the local improvement concerning the Urbana Water and Walnut Street Improvement No. 253-78CS, in the City of Urbana, Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS: That -

SECTION 1. In connection with the construction of the local improvement designated as the Urbana Water and Walnut Street Improvement No. 253-78CS, in the City of Urbana, Illinois, it will be necessary for the City to take by condemnation for public purposes, the following described real estate, to-wit:

The North 12 feet of the South 22 feet of that part of Outlot 3 of the Original Town of Urbana, now City of Urbana,

bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 8, Township 19, North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, thence North 224 feet along the East line of said  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of said Section 8, thence East 973.75 feet along a line parallel to the South line of the  $E\frac{1}{2}$  of said Section 8, to a true point of beginning, thence East along the North line of Water Street in the City of Urbana, 312.5 feet, thence North along the West line of Vine Street 214.5 feet, thence West along a line parallel to the North line of said Water Street 314 feet, thence South along the East line of Walnut Street extended 214.5 feet to the true point of beginning, situate, lying and being in the  $S\frac{1}{2}$  of the  $SE\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8, Township 19, North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, in the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, except the West 200 feet thereof of even width,

and, therefore, said real estate is condemned for that purpose.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from

and after the date of its passage and approval as required by law.
