AN ORDINANCE FIXING COMPENSATION OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES  
OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS: -

SECTION I. That beginning May 1, 1956, the monthly salaries of the following named officers and employees of the City of Urbana, Illinois, shall be as follows:

SECTION II. Beginning May 1, 1956, the annual salary of the Corporation Counsel shall be - .....\$200.00

SECTION III. For each regular or special meeting of the City Council attended by him, each alderman shall receive a compensation of ..... 10.00

SECTION IV. All employees who shall have been employed continuously for a minimum of one year upon the public streets or public sewers shall receive wages at the rate of \$315.00 per month. All other employees in the Street Department or working in the Sewer or Drainage Department, who shall be employed by the City for less than one year, and all helpers of the City Electrician or working in the Electrical Department shall receive \$1.45 per hour.

SECTION V. Each member of the Civil Service Commission shall receive \$10.00 per year as payment for his services on the said Commission.

SECTION VI. If the Commissioner of Public Works, Assistant Building Inspector, and City Electrician furnish their own automobile or trucks for use in City Business, then for such use the City shall pay the Commissioner of Public Works for gasoline, oil, insurance, repairs and depreciation, the sum of \$60.00 per month, and shall pay the Assistant Building Inspector for such items and use the sum of \$50.00 per month, and shall pay the City Electrician for such items and use, the sum of \$60.00 per month.

SECTION VII. In addition to the compensation hereinabove fixed, the Corporation Counsel shall receive such compensation for services to the Board of Local Improvements of the City of Urbana, Illinois, as shall from time to time be determined by the Board of Local Improvements of said City, and nothing herein contained shall be construed as limiting the Board of Local Improvements in paying the said officer compensation for services rendered to said Board.

SECTION VIII. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
