

ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE OF THE
CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING
MAY 1, 1956, AND ENDING APRIL 30, 1957

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, did on the 25th day of June, 1956; being within the first quarter of the fiscal year of said City which began on May 1st, 1956 and ends on April 30th, 1957, adopt the annual appropriation bill of said City for the fiscal year beginning May 1st, 1956, which said ordinance was approved by the Mayor who signed the same on the 25th day of June, 1956, and the same was duly published on June 25, 1956, as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, for the purpose of supplying a revenue to meet said appropriation: -

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS: -

SECTION 1. That there is hereby levied and assessed upon all property subject to taxation within said City of Urbana, Illinois, as the same is assessed and equalized for state and county purpose for the current fiscal year, the sum of \$50,900.00; which sum is exclusive of any and all amounts hereinafter levied for the purposes authorized by acts which by their terms provide that taxes may be levied for such purpose, and when levied shall be in addition to taxes for general corporate purposes, and is hereby levied for the fiscal year beginning May 1st, 1956 and ending April 30th, 1957, for the particular purposes as follows:



AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX FOR STREET AND BRIDGE PURPOSES IN THE TOWN OF CUNNINGHAM, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 1956, AND ENDING APRIL 30, 1957

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, Illinois, includes wholly within its corporate limits, the Town of Cunningham, and, therefore, comes within the provisions of Section 69-6 of Chapter 24 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Illinois, for the levying of a street and bridge tax,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That there be and is hereby levied upon all taxable property within the Township of Cunningham, Champaign County, Illinois, lying wholly within the corporate limits of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for street and bridge purposes in the Town of Cunningham, Champaign County, Illinois, the sum of \$14,800.00, pursuant to the provisions of Section 69-6, of Chapter 24 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Illinois.


