AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE CODE  
OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS  
OF 1954

---

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That the following Section 14.5-1 be added to the Code of the City of Urbana, Illinois of 1954:

Sec. 14.5-1. Dumping Garbage From Non-City Property.

It shall be unlawful for any sanitary hauler to dump garbage, debris or waste material of any kind upon the City Dumping Grounds of the City of Urbana unless such waste material was hauled from a property or location within the corporate limits of the City of Urbana, or was hauled from a property outside of the corporate limits of the City of Urbana from family units which have paid an annual permit fee to the City in the amount of \$5.00 for each such family unit or from commercial establishments which have paid a fee of \$10.00 for each such commercial establishment. On payment of such fee to the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, said Clerk shall issue to each payor a metal tag which may be attached to the garbage container of the commercial establishment or family unit to indicate that the permit fee has been paid.

All fees received for such Non-City garbage permits shall be deposited by the City Clerk in the Garbage Disposal Fund of the City.


Within ten days after the City Council requests from a sanitary hauler, a list of family units from which garbage and debris is collected, such sanitary hauler shall furnish such list, and failure to supply such a list within the prescribed time shall result in the revocation of the license of a sanitary hauler refusing to supply the list.

The City Council may revoke the license of any sanitary hauler who uses the Urbana Dumping Grounds illegally or in violation of the rules and regulations of the City Council pertaining to same, or uses said Dumping Grounds in violation of this ordinance.


Whenever the majority of the residents in an area and a majority of the property owners therein have filed a petition for annexation of such area in the County Court of Champaign County, Illinois, and when a

copy of the notice of the hearing upon such annexation petition has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, then it shall be permissible thereafter for sanitary haulers to dump garbage, debris and other waste materials from the area described in said petition in the Urbana City Dumping Grounds.
