

ORDINANCE LOCATING FIRE HYDRANTS

WHEREAS, the Chief of the Fire Department of the City of Urbana, Illinois has recommended to the City Council that Fire Hydrants be located at the locations hereinafter mentioned; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, from the standpoint of public safety and fire protection, to have said Fire Hydrants so located.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS: That Fire Hydrants be located and installed at the following locations, to-wit:

- 1. The intersection of Fairlawn Drive and Eastern Drive.
- 2. The intersection of Cottage Grove and Eastern Drive.
- 3. The intersection of Cole Place and Eastern Drive.
- 4. The intersection of Patton Place and Eastern Drive.
- 5. The intersection of Patton Place and Fairlawn Drive.

Such Fire Hydrants shall be installed at the above mentioned locations by the Northern Illinois Water Corporation within sixty (60) days of the date of the adoption of this ordinance, a copy of the ordinance shall be forwarded to said Northern Illinois Water Corporation forthwith.


