AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY

---

WHEREAS, the adjoining property owners, by proper petition addressed to the City Council of the City of Urbana, have asked for the closing of an alley which runs east and west through Block 37 of Seminary Addition from Wright Street to Romine Street in the City of Urbana, Illinois, and

WHEREAS, it appears that there are no objectors to the closing of said alley, but that all of the owners of the abutting property on the entire alley have signed said petition requesting the vacation thereof, and

WHEREAS, it appears that three-fourths of the Aldermen elected are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana to vacate said alley.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:


SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, hereby vacates and releases to the owners of the abutting property, all right, title and interest of the City of Urbana to the alley located and described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest (NW) corner of Lot Seven (?) of Block Thirty-seven (37) of Seminary Addition to the City of Urbana, thence North Sixteen Feet Six inches (16.5') thence East to Romine Street, thence South Sixteen Feet Six inches (16.5') to the Northeast corner (NE) of Lot Twelve (12) of Block Thirty-seven (37) of said Addition, thence West to the place of beginning, all situated in the City of Urbana, County of Champaign, and State of Illinois.


SECTION 2. The City of Urbana, Illinois hereby reserves an easement or right-of-way upon or under the ground in said alley to be used for public utility services and for the installation of sewers and drains and for the maintenance and repair of such public utility property or sewers and drains which may be located in or under said alley.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
