


AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE  
AT RETAIL OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS WITHIN THE CITY OF  
URBANA, ILLINOIS


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:  
That An Ordinance Regulating the Sale at Retail of Alcoholic Liquors Within  
the City of Urbana, Illinois, enacted May 17, 1954 and effective July 15,  
1954 is hereby amended by adding the following Section 4.1 thereto:

Section 4.1. Whenever by virtue of the annexation of an area or  
territory to the City of Urbana, Illinois, an establishment possessing a  
Liquor License becomes subject to the provisions of this Ordinance, then  
there shall automatically be added one additional license to the number of  
licenses authorized in Section 4 hereof for the proper classification  
corresponding to the type of license held by the establishment at the time  
of the annexation, and the premises used by such establishment shall be  
automatically included in the liquor zone established by Section 11 of  
this Ordinance.
