ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS WITHIN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS:

That An Ordinance Regulating the Sale at Retail of Alcoholic
Liquors Within the City of Urbana, Illinois, adopted and approved on
May 17, 1954, is hereby amended by adding the following Section 25-A
thereto:


SECTION 25-A. (Drinking in Non-Licensed Public Places Prohibited.)

No person shall bring nor shall any proprietor permit to be brought any
alcoholic liquor in any form into any dining room or any hotel, restaurant,
club room or any public place where food is served, or where any soft drinks
are sold or any soda fountain is operated, for consumption or for the mixing
of same with other beverages. It shall be unlawful for any person to consume
liquor in any non-licensed public place within the City or at any place upon
the streets of this City.
