

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE
WHICH REGULATES THE RATES OF FARE AND
CHARGES FOR TAXICAB SERVICE WITHIN THE
CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS
ADOPTED OCTOBER 1, 1951

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS:


That an ordinance which regulates the rates of fare and charges for taxicab service within the City of Urbana, Illinois, adopted October 1, 1951, as appears in the Code of Urbana, Illinois, 1954, Section 31.44, be amended in reference to the first sentence of said section, to provide as follows:

Sec. 31.44: Rates of Fare -- Generally

The charges for taxicab service for one passenger shall be thirty-five cents for the first one-third of a mile or fraction thereof, and ten cents for each succeeding one-third mile or fraction thereof, and if more than one passenger is carried on the same trip, there shall be an additional charge of five cents for each such additional passenger who leaves the taxicab prior to or at the time the meter is cleared.


This ordinance shall operate in full force and effect from this 16th day of September, A.D. 1957.
