AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED
AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING REGULATIONS FOR THE
SUBDIVISION OF LAND, ADOPTED BY THE CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS ON
JULY 1, 1957

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS:

Section 3.B.8. of the Ordinance Providing Regulations
for the Subdivision of Land, Adopted by the City Council of the City
of Urbana, Illinois, on July 1, 1957, which provides:

8. Cul-de-sacs shall have a maximum length of 300 feet
measured from the center line of the intersecting street to the
center of the turnaround.

Shall hereby be amended to provide as follows:

8. Cul-de-sacs shall have a maximum length of 300 feet
measured from the center line of the intersecting street to the
center of the turnaround; provided, however, cul-de-sacs which are
furnished with an adequate crossing or exit at the extremities of the
turnarounds, can have additional length so that such cul-de-sacs not
exceed a maximum length of 900 feet, measured from the center line of
the intersecting street to the center of the turnaround. Such em-
ergency crossing or exit must be connected with another thoroughfare
and be adequate to support and allow passage of all emergency vehicles;
and such crossings and exits shall be dedicated to the public use, with
a width of at least twenty feet.

This Amendment Ordinance shall operate in full force and
effect from this 18th day of November, A.D. 1957.
