

ORDINANCE FOR PROVISION
FOR BOARD OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS
OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS the applicable portion of Section 84-6 of the Cities and Villages Act in effect, Illinois Revised Statutes, in Chapter 24, provides:

"In cities having a population of less than 50,000,...the board of local improvements shall consist of the mayor of the city,...who shall be president of the board, and the public engineer and the superintendent of streets of the municipality, where such officers are provided by ordinance. But if at any time such officers are not provided for, the corporate authorities, by ordinance shall designate two or more members of their body who, with the mayor...shall constitute the members of the board, until otherwise provided by ordinance.";

and

WHEREAS the ordinances of the City of Urbana provide that the mayor may employ a city engineer and the compensation ordinance for the current year provides for a city or public engineer, and whereas an engineer is not now employed by the City of Urbana, Illinois, as a public engineer, and whereas unless and until a public engineer is so appointed and employed, by the mayor with the approval of the City Council, the Board of Local Improvements is otherwise to be formed;

and

WHEREAS the ordinances of the City of Urbana provides for a Superintendent of Streets and the compensation ordinance for the current year provides compensation for a Superintendent of Streets and whereas HENRY WITTIG is employed and appointed as such Superintendent of Streets;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, that HENRY WITTIG is the Superintendent of Streets, and the Superintendent of Streets, and Alderman Richard A. Parks, and Mayor STANLEY B. WEAVER, all of said City, constitute and are the members of the Board of Local Improvements of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and the mayor is the President of the Board of Local Improvements.
