AMENDMENTS TO THE CODE OF THE CITY
OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, 1954.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That Section 30.51 of the Code of the City of Urbana,
Illinois, 1954, shall read as follows:

Sec. 30.51. Permit required.

No person shall move any building on, through or
over any street, alley or sidewalk, park or other
public place without having obtained a permit there-
for from the Commissioner of Public Works.

That Section 30.52 of the Code of the City of Urbana,
Illinois, 1954, shall read as follows:

Sec. 30.52. Application for permit.

Application for permits as requested by section 30.51
of this Code; shall be made in writing to the
Commissioner of Public Works and shall state the
proposed route and the number of days it is
estimated that the building should occupy any portion
of any street, alley, sidewalk, park or public place.

That Section 30.56 of the Code of the City of Urbana,
Illinois, 1954, shall read as follows:

Sec.30.56. Special permit for removing, injuring, etc.,
trees, plants or shrubs.


No person shall move any building along any street or
over any public ground of the City in such a way as to
remove, trim, destroy, break, cut, deface or in any way
injure any tree, plant or shrub growing in any street
or public highway of the City without a special permit
from the Commissioner of Public Works.

That Section 30.57 of the Code of the City of Urbana,
Illinois, 1954, shall read as follows:


Sec. 30.57. Width of streets.

No building shall be moved over any street in the
City unless the width of the pavement thereon from
face to face of curb shall equal the width of the
building.
