

ORDINANCEFOR THE LOCATION OF A FIRE HYDRANT.

W H E R E A S Chief of the Fire Department of the City of Urbana, Illinois, recommends to the City Council, that a fire hydrant be located at a location hereinafter designated, and

W H E R E A S it appears to be for the best interests for the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, from the standpoint of public safety and fire protection, to have said fire hydrant so located.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that there is a necessity for a fire hydrant at the following specified location, and that a hydrant be placed and installed at said location by the Northern Illinois Water Corporation, and the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Northern Illinois Water Corporation.


The location for said fire hydrant in the City of Urbana, Illinois, is to be as follows:

At the Southeast corner of the intersection of East Main Street and Lierman Avenue, to be connected to a 10 inch water main which is to be installed along the South side of Main Street, from the Magnavox property to the Champaign County Nursing Home property.


