ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE A PERMIT  
TO REMOVE TREES

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that this Ordinance shall be known as "Ordinance to require a permit to remove trees"; and the purpose of this Ordinance is to provide for indemnity to the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation, against any damage or liability caused by felling or removal of any tree or trees in the said City of Urbana, Illinois.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois.


Section 1. No tree with a trunk diameter in excess of six inches, shall be felled or removed in the City of Urbana, Illinois, on, over or across the public property of said City, unless the contractor first obtains a permit for such work from the Commissioner of Public Works.

Section 2. Such permit shall cost One dollar (\$1.00), and shall be issued on forms obtained from the Commissioner of Public Works


Section 3. In the event of any damage to property of the said City of Urbana, the extent of such damage shall be determined by the Commissioner of Public Works or the City Council of said City, in an appropriate sum, and in such event, the Contractor shall restore the property in a satisfactory manner as reasonably determined by the Commissioner of Public Works, or the City Council of said City, within ~~thirty~~ thirty days after the damage is done, or the Contractor shall pay said City for such damage within thirty days after the damage is done. In the event any damage or injury is caused to any person or property, the Contractor shall save said City harmless from liability.

Any person or persons violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be subject to penalty as set forth in Section 1.6 of the Urbana City Code.
