## AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that a petition was filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, on the 31st day of July A.D. 1959, requesting the annexation of the territory hereinafter described, which said petition was signed under oath by the sole owner of record of real estate and there being no electors residing in said territory, and

WHEREAS, at least two-thirds of the aldermen are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said territory be annexed to, and made a part of the city limits of said City.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS.

SECTION 1. That the territory described as follows, to-wit:

South 40 feet of the following described tract of land: East 42 Rods of the west half  $(W_2^{\frac{1}{2}})$  of the northeast quarter  $(NE_{\frac{1}{4}})$ , and the east half  $(E_2^{\frac{1}{2}})$  of the northeast quarter  $(NE_{\frac{1}{4}})$  of Section Sixteen (16), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Nine (9) East of the Third Principal Meridian, situated in the County of Champaign and State of Illinois,

be, and the same is hereby annexed to, and shall hereafter be a part of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the corporate limits of said City be, and the same shall be changed so as to include said territory within the corporate limits of said City,

SECTION 2. The City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, shall record with the Recorder of Deeds of the County of Champaign, Illinois, a copy of this ordinance together with an accurate map of the annexed territory.
