

AN ORDINANCE OF AMENDMENT TO THE  
 PLUMBING CODE OF THE CITY OF URBANA,  
 ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the Ordinance entitled "Plumbing Ordinance" adopted by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and approved by the Mayor on the 2nd day of March, A.D. 1959, be amended, changed and adopted to further provide as follows:


Article 14, 17 3(d), permits and fees, shall be changed to read:

We shall issue all permits required by ordinance or regulation, retaining one copy in permanent book form in his office and deliver original to person applying for same, and shall collect the following fees therefor:


For permission to connect to the sanitary sewer or storm drain and inspection therefor, the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) shall be charged and collected. A Permit and a fee of Three Dollars (\$3.00) will be required for making an excavation in any of the public streets or alley for the purpose of laying or replacing or repairing any drain tile or connecting water pipe, gas pipe, telephone conduits or appurtenances belonging to the equipment of any public sewer corporation. For permission to construct a septic tank with proper disposal field and inspection therefor, the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) shall be charged and collected. A permit and fee of Two Dollars (\$2.00) for each fixture shall be required and collected for plumbing installed in new buildings or for the addition to or alteration of existing plumbing.

The word fixture being here meant to include all openings left for waste or for the installation of pipes whether the fixtures are set or not.
