ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 1959 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 1960.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, did on the 6th day of July, 1959, being within the first quarter of the fiscal year of said City which began on May 1st, 1959, and ends on April 30th, 1960, adopt the annual appropriation ordinance of said City for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 1959, which said ordinance was approved by the Mayor who signed the same on the 6th day of July, 1959, and the same was duly published on July 9, 1959, as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, for the purpose of supplying a revenue to meet said appropriation:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS
