## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MOTOR VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC ORDINANCE OF THE URBANA CITY CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that the Motor Vehicle and Traffic Ordinances of the City of Urbana, Illinois, as compiled in the Code of the City of Urbana, Illinois, 1954, as amended, be further amended to add in Article 3, Traffic Control Devises, Sec. 20.17 Traffic-control Signal legend, the following paragraph:

- (f) Yellow when followed by red signal for school crossings.
- 1. Vehicular traffic facing such signal shall not enter the nearest crosswalk at an intersection nor proceed beyond such other point as may be indicated by a clearly visible line while this signal is displayed until the expiration of the showing of the red signal which is a part of that cycle.
- 2. No pedestrian facing such signal shall enter the road-way unless he can do so safely and without interfering with any vehicular traffic.
