AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE FOR FIRE HYDRANT

WHEREAS, the Chief of the Fire Department of the City of Urbana, Illinois, the fire Marshall, recommends to the City Council that a fire hydrant be located 455 feet north of the center line of Eads Street, on the east side of North Goodwin Avenue, and in said city, and

WHEREAS, this ordinance amends a prior ordinance in reference to the location of said fire hydrant, adopted by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, on the 3rd day of August, A. D. 1959, and

WHEREAS, it appears to be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for public safety and fire protection to have such fire hydrant so located.


