AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS OF 1950.

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission of the City of Urbana, Illinois, which is the City Zone Commission, did on Friday, the 8th day of January, A.D. 1960, at the hour of 4:00 o'clock P.M. conduct a public hearing pursuant to the required public notice, in the Community Building at the address of 120 W. Elm Street, Urbana, Illinois, to consider the hereinafter described proposed amendment to said Zoning Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, said Plan Commission at said hearing heard all persons desiring to be heard either for or against said amendment, and found that such proposed amendment is desirable for the public welfare of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the same is not detrimental to the property owners in the vicinity, and,

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission recommended the amendment as hereinafter described for adoption by the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

Reclassification and rezoning of the following described real estate from the classification of R-2 District- Multiple Family Residentail Area, to the classification of I-2 District- Light Industrial Area; the description of said real estate is, to-wit:

Block 37 of Seminary Addition to the City of Urbana, situated in the City of Urbana, County of Champaign and State of Illinois.
