

AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 20, MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE I, SECTION 20.1 DEFINITIONS, IN THE CODE OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, 1954

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

THAT Chapter 20, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Article I, Section 20.1, Definitions, in the Code of the City of Urbana, Illinois be amended by the addition of the definitions, as follows:

Signs, Stop. Any signs placed by the City for warning to an approaching motor vehicle driver that he must stop at such sign provides that such motorist must stop at such sign, and proceed only at such time as there is a safe interval in traffic on the intersection.

Signs, Yield. Any sign placed by the City for warning to a motor vehicles driver that he must yield to traffic, provides that he must slow down to a rate not more than twenty (20) miles per hour, and proceed only at such time as there is a safe interval in traffic on the intersecting street.
