

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS OF 1950.

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission of the City of Urbana, which is the City Zone Commission, did on Friday, the 18th day of March, A.D. 1960, at the hour of 4:00 O'clock P.M. conduct a public hearing pursuant to the required public notice, in the Community Building at the address of 120 W Elm Street, Urbana, Illinois, to consider the hereinafter described proposed amendment to said Zoning Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, said Plan Commission at said hearing heard all persons desiring to be heard either for or against said amendment, and found that such proposed amendment is desirable for the public welfare of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and that the same is not detrimental to the property owners in the vicinity, and,

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission recommended the amendment as hereinafter described for adoption of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

Reclassification and rezoning of the following described real estate from the classification of R-1 District, Single and Two Family Residential Area, to the classification of R-2 District, Multiple Family Residential Area; the description of said real estate is, to-wit:

Lots Nos. 22 and 23 in Forest Park Addition to Urbana, being a part of the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 17, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, situated in Champaign County, Illinois.
