

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A FEE SCHEDULE FOR DEPOSITING DISCARDED BUILDING MATERIALS INCLUDING NON-BURNABLE AND NON-DECOMPOSING MATERIAL AT THE MUNICIPAL DUMP GROUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Municipal dump grounds is operated as a sanitary land-fill system and garbage deposits thereon are covered and ultimately decomposes permitting re-use of the same land, and

WHEREAS, broken concrete, bricks, and other non-decomposing and non-burnable materials require special handling in order to permit normal operation of the sanitary land-fill system, now therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person, firm, or corporation shall deposit discarded building materials, including broken concrete, bricks, lumber, metal building materials, plaster, and non-decomposing and non-burnable substances at the Municipal Dump Grounds without first obtaining a permit or providing the dump grounds operator with signed authorization for billing of charges as hereinafter provided.
  2. Permits for depositing such non-decomposing and/or non-burnable materials of any citizen of the City of Urbana not engaging in the building or contracting business, or in any operation connected therewith, may be obtained from the City Clerk's office for a fee of \$1.00 per load.
  3. Permits for depositing such non-decomposing and/or non-burnable materials by any non-resident of the City of Urbana not engaging in the building or contracting business, or in any operation connected therewith may be obtained from the City Clerk's office for a fee of \$5.00 per load.
  4. Load permits issued by the City Clerk for residents or non-residents of the City of Urbana will be valid for a period of only 48 hours after date of issuance.
  5. Charges for the dumping of contractor's rubble including non-burnable and non-decomposing materials by bona fide businesses, firms, or corporations located inside the City of Urbana will be as follows:
    - A. \$1.00 per load of burnable material dumped at the burning area or decomposable materials dumped in the sanitary fill.
    - B. \$2.00 per load of non-burnable or non-decomposable material.
    - C. \$4.00 per load for mixed loads of burnable or decomposable material with non-burnable or non-decomposable material.
- No weekly, monthly, or annual permits shall be issued for this type of dumping.
6. Charges for the dumping of contractor's rubble including non-burnable and non-decomposable materials by businesses, firms, or corporations located outside the City limits of the City of Urbana will be \$5.00 per load.
  7. Contractors and other businesses desiring to utilize the municipal dump ground facilities under the provisions hereof shall register with the City Clerk. The City Clerk shall furnish the custodian of the dump grounds with a list of all such resident and non-resident contractors and other businesses and the dump grounds operator shall permit dumping of residue only by such registered contractors or other businesses or their duly authorized agents. Charges as listed in Sections 5 and 6 above for the dumping of contractor's rubble, etc., will be billed by the office of the City Clerk at the end of each month with said billing to be based on the per load tabulation submitted by the custodian of the City Dump Grounds and based

on the actual per load tabulation made at the dump grounds site.

The custodian of the dump grounds will require each driver dumping materials for a building contractor or any contract operation to sign a per load authorization for billing, indicating the party to be billed prior to being permitted to dump his residue.

8. The custodian of the city dump grounds shall not permit any person, firm, or corporation, or their agents to dump at the City dump grounds without presentation of a valid garbage collector's or hauler's license, resident or non-resident dumping permit, or without first securing the signatures authorizing the City Clerk to bill the person, firm, or corporation involved in depositing the discarded building materials.

9. For the purposes of this ordinance, the custodian of the municipal dump grounds can act as a deputy for the City Clerk so far as necessary in the administration of this ordinance.

10. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions hereof shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) or more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

11. The granting of permission to use said garbage disposal grounds upon payment of the required fees shall be not mandatory upon the part of the City, and shall be granted only as capacity of the garbage disposal grounds will permit.

12. This ordinance shall control in regard to the subject of depositing discarded building materials including non-burnable and non-decomposable material at the Municipal Dump Grounds and special fees for the same, as provided in this ordinance.
