

AMENDED ORDINANCE IN REGARD TO SEPARATION OF
STREET TRAFFIC LANES


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the Ordinance which amended Section 20.30 of the Code of the City of Urbana, Illinois, of 1954, by the addition of Subsection (b) (4) be further amended to the Subsection so that Subsection (b) (4) now provides as follows:

On or along the central lines of pavements, or between pavement traffic lanes, marked with a solid yellow line or yellow lines marked on the center lines of pavements, or between pavement traffic lanes, vehicles shall not cross such lines, except vehicle crossings are to be permitted, in order to make turns into driveways, alleys, or street entrances along streets so marked by such yellow lines, and also except in emergencies as defined in the Statutes, Laws, and Ordinances in force in said City.
