

ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 1962, AND ENDING APRIL 30, 1963

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, did on the 2nd day of July, 1962, being within the first quarter of the fiscal year of said City which began on May 1st, 1962, and ends on April 30th, 1963, adopt the annual appropriation ordinance of said City for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 1962, which said ordinance was approved by the Mayor who signed the same on the 2nd day of July, 1962, and the same was duly published on July 3rd, 1962, as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, for the purpose of supplying a revenue to meet said appropriation:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby levied and assessed upon all property subject to taxation within said City of Urbana, Illinois, as the same is assessed and equalized for state and county purposes for the current fiscal year, the sum of \$98,200.00 ; which sum is exclusive of any and all amounts hereinafter levied for the purposes authorized by acts which by their terms provide that taxes may be levied for such purposes, and when levied shall be in addition to taxes for general corporate purposes, and is hereby levied for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 1962, and ending April 30, 1963, for the particular purposes as follows:
