

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION
OF EAST HIGH STREET

WHEREAS, three-fourths of all the Aldermen of the City of Urbana, Illinois, authorized by law to be elected, have determined that the public interest will be subserved by vacating a certain portion of East High Street in the City of Urbana, Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

The City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, hereby vacates that portion of East High Street east of Vine Street, in the City of Urbana, Illinois, as described and bounded as follows, to-wit:


Commencing at the Southwest corner of Lot Seven (7) in Block One (1) of George Webber's First Addition to the City of Urbana, Illinois, thence easterly along the south boundary of said Lot 7 to the Southeast corner of said lot, thence southerly to the Northeast corner of Lot Two (2) in Block Two (2) of said George Webber's First Addition, thence westerly along the north boundary of said Lot 2 to the Northwest corner of said lot, thence northerly along the east boundary of Vine Street to the Southwest corner of said Lot 7, all situated in the City of Urbana, County of Champaign and State of Illinois.

And the title of the land included within said portion of said street so vacated shall vest in the City of Urbana, Illinois, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Illinois, the owners of the real estate abutting on the north and south sides of said portion of said street.

ADOPTED by an affirmative vote of three-fourths of the elected Aldermen of the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, this 16th day of July, 1962.
