

CITY ORDINANCE
AMENDMENT TO GARBAGE, HAULING, AND
DUMP GROUND PROVISIONS, CHAPTER 14
OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS, 1954

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the last two paragraphs of Section 14.3, Sanitary Hauling, Chapter 14, Garbage, Trash and Weeds, Article I, In General, be repealed.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that said Section 14.3 is amended by the addition as follows; that, every vehicle used for the transfer of such garbage through the streets of said City shall be provided with a watertight bed or receptacle, having a closed cover and be so constructed that no portion of the garbage conveyed therein shall be scattered or left in or upon any sidewalk, street, or alley of said City. Any person, firm, or corporation using a vehicle or appliance in the transfer of any garbage, other than of the kind or character herein specified, or who shall scatter, leave or deposit any garbage upon any street, sidewalk, or alley of said City, or who shall violate any of the provisions of this Article shall be subject to a penalty of not less than \$3.00 for each offense, and upon conviction for a second offense, shall be subject to forfeiture or suspension of such license.

Any licensed hauler operating under a special permit (Sec.14.5) will be required to present his truck for periodic inspection as requested by the City Marshall, (Chief of Police Department).

Sanitary haulers will separate, or maintain the loads separate according to the following classifications of materials:

1. Materials suitable for land fill disposal.
2. Brush, limbs, trees and other burnable material.
3. Construction rubble, metal and other nonburnable trash, not suitable for land fill disposal methods.

The disposition of materials at the City Dump Ground will be in the locations as direction by the Custodian or his assistants.

Noncompliance with the directions of the Custodian of the dump grounds or his authorized assistants will subject offenders to penalties under the provisions of Section 2.15, and subject offenders to the penalty set out in Section 1.6 of this Code.

In addition, the repeated violators will be subject to suspension or revocation of license by action of the City Council.
